RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, it is apparent to this Commissioners Court that annexing territory within Brazos County by the larger municipalities located within the county can be at times controversial; and

WHEREAS, this Court has an interest in the welfare of all Brazos County residents, and all the institutions that serve them; and

WHEREAS, fiscal impact studies conducted by the City of College Station in the annexation process of the Wellborn Community only addresses municipal finances and not the impact on county residents or other institutions serving them; and

WHEREAS, an assessment of the economic impact of annexation on county residents and the institutions that serve them is important for a complete and accurate understanding of the implications of annexation; and

WHEREAS, this Commissioners Court is of the opinion that the citizens of Brazos County should be given the right to vote on whether or not annexation is in their best interest; and

WHEREAS, there is legislation pending in the Texas Legislature, if when passed, would allow citizens of the county the right to vote on pending annexations; and

WHEREAS, this Court is of the opinion that an independent economic analysis should be completed that would address the impact of annexation on county residents and the institutions that serve them, specifically the South Brazos County Fire Department, allowing a more informed annexation vote should that possibility be realized;

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED by the Commissioners Court of Brazos County, Texas that the City of College Station not proceed with annexation of the Wellborn Community until an independent economic analysis of the impact of such an annexation on county residents involved and the institutions that serve them is completed.
