BAC Historical Summary: Major Milestones

- Thursday, September 1, 2011: one full-time care tech
- •Tuesday, September 6, 2011: three full-time care techs
- •Thursday, October 13, 2011: Veterinarian inspection
- •Friday, January 13, 2012: dog kennels installed
- •Monday, January 30, 2012: BAC supervisor begins
- •Monday, February 27, 2012: State inspection (quarantine)
- •Tuesday, March 6, 2012:
 - ✓ 6 months and 6 days of operations (188 days)
 - ✓ from impound to full-service with more to come

Initial Projected Estimates(1)(2)

- February/March 2011: ASAC and City Council
 - **Expenses:**
 - ➤ Impound Only: \$435,000.00
 - >"Full Service": \$725,000.00
 - **Revenue:** \$140,000.00
 - ■Start-Up Costs: \$200,000.00
 - ■Kennel Costs: ~\$100,000.00
 - ■New Facility: \$500,000.00
 - (1) based on limited financial information and lack of history
 - (2) figures are rounded

Notes:

- 1. BAC is part of the Environmental Services budget and not a separate budget
- 2. Environmental Services provides \$300,000.00 for BAC operations
- 3. General Fund provides \$80,000.00 for BAC operations
- 4. Brazos Animal Shelter costs of services was to be approx. \$380,000.00 (FY2012)
- 5. Start-Up Costs do not include \$98,155.96 the City Council approved for kennels on April 12, 2011 (a planned expenditure whether City or BAS service)

6. does **not** include \$500,000.00 for new facility as was discussed with BAS

BAC FY2013 Budget Projections

	Initial Estimated Projections
Revenues	\$ 100,000.00
Expenses	\$ 395,702.00
Revenues/Expenses (net)	\$ (295,702.00)

Notes:

- 1. Based on six (6) months of initial operation in FY2012
- 2. Estimated expense per animal: \$131.90 based on 3,000 animals
- 3. Estimated **net** expense per animal: \$98.57 based on 3,000 animals

Statistics cont.

- •Inspections: Annually by Local Vet and State (State Health Services)
 - ✓ Local Facility Inspection: October 13, 2011
 - ✓ State Quarantine Inspection: February 27, 2012 (final doc pending)
- •Intake/Animal Control: 78% (1065)
- •Intake/Owner Surrender: 5%
- •Reclaim Rate: 14%
- •Adoption Rate: 36%
- •Euthanasia Rate: 38%
 - ✓ includes all "Euthanized" categories
 - ✓ does **not** include "Deceased in Custody" (2%)
 - ✓ of the 38%, ~15% attributed to cats/behavioral






