





## **CSHS BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

- The building of College Station High School was approved by CSISD voters in May 2009.
- The \$144.2 million bond, which also included the construction of Greens Prairie Elementary, the Transportation Center and AMCHS renovations, passed with 71.14% of the vote.

## TRANSITIONING TO TWO COMPREHENSIVE HIGH SCHOOLS

- College Station High School will open the 2012-13 school year with ninth and 10th graders only, and will add a grade each year until fully implemented in 2014-15. The first graduating class for CSHS will be the Class of 2015.
- College Station High School and A&M Consolidated High School will offer the same courses and programs with the exception of a few Career and Technology Education classes.
- In the 2011-12 school year AMCHS had 2,812 students, while having a capacity of approximately 2,400. When the secondary attendance zones are fully-implemented in 2014-15, it is projected AMCHS will have approximately 1,600 students and CSHS will have approximately 1,400 students.
