Development

- Greens Prairie Trail/Royder Road
 - CoCS assures capacity at lift station for up to four facilities on Eidson and Nelson tracts
 - CSISD agrees to deed land at the Eidson site for a fire station
 - CoCS agrees to reimburse CSISD for their half of the cost of extending the fiber optic cable network

Facilities

- Leases for city parks
 - CSISD leases district property to CoCS for \$1 per year
 - CoCS constructs park/playground facilities
 - CoCS is responsible for O&M
