
Discussion, consideration, and possible action to


Direct the city staff to write or change the appropriate ordinance to require licensing by the [Texas Department of Aging and Disability Services \( DADS \)](#) of Assisted living facilities or Personal care homes, or any residential establishment that provides food, shelter and personal care services to four or less persons unrelated to the proprietor of the establishment and allow grandfather of the license requirement for no more than a year.
