Margaret O'Quinn Memorial Service

On Sunday, July 26, 2015, there will be a memorial service honoring the life of service and generosity of Margaret O'Quinn, co-founder and longtime co-director of Still Creek Ranch.

In late June, O'Quinn was hospitalized for bacterial meningitis. She improved at first, but then took a turn for the worse, and passed away on July 5th.

During her lifetime, Margaret O'Quinn impacted hundreds of children's lives, providing them with hope and a future through the saving truth of Jesus Christ. O'Quinn and her husband, Danny, founded and ran the ranch for abused, neglected and abandoned children for 24 years. Through their passion and service, Still Creek Ranch grew from a 14 acre boys home to a 286 acre ranch that now cares for 28 male and female residents coming out of crisis, as well as educates many more children from the community through the on-site private Christian academy.

The O'Quinns, who were honored in 2009 with Jefferson Awards for their service to the community, stepped down and moved to Folsom, New Mexico in 2012. They helped start "The Children of Promise" camp for orphans and abused children.

The memorial service will take place at the Brazos County Expo Center, located at 5827 Leonard Road, Bryan, Texas. The service is scheduled to begin at 2:00 pm and the public is welcome and encouraged to attend. There will be an opportunity for those who were touched by Margaret's life to share their experiences and love for her.
