Please place the following item on the Bryan City Council Regular Agenda for the regularly scheduled second meeting of October 2015:


Discussion, consideration, and possible action to direct City Staff to investigate and recommend the possibilities of having a city sponsored vendor to collect recyclable waste from residences. The expense should be borne by the participants on a voluntary basis and not affect the current city recycle programs. A recommendation should be brought back to the City Council by the last meeting in November 2015 or sooner.


Discussion: College Station currently has apparently successful program that may be duplicated in Bryan. Some Bryan residents have requested a recycle program that collects waste from a residence. Such a collection program will potentially keep more waste from the landfill.
