SUBJECT:

Accept the Low Bid to Re-roof of the Administration Building on the Bryan Campus

RECOMMENDATION:

The Administration recommends that the Blinn Board of Trustees accept the low bid from the prospective bidders to reroof the Administration Building on the Bryan Campus according to plans and specifications issued by Aestimo, Inc.

RATIONALE:

A complete interior renovation of the Administration Building was recently completed for the fall 2015 semester to house the Blinn Bookstore, Blinn Police Department, Human Resources, President's office and various other administrative offices. At the time of the renovation, it was determined that the roof could be repaired to address leaks. The roof is a metal roof, and the panels appeared to be in satisfactory condition.

After completion of the project, the building continued to leak, but in areas that were not previously leaking. Facilities attempted to repair these leaks, using professional roofers, but when new leaks continued to surface, it became apparent that the lap joints and screws were in poor condition.

Facilities evaluated a number of possibilities available to the college to address the leaks including patching the joints, applying a protective coating to the entire roof and reroofing the building. It was determined, after comparing the advantages and disadvantages of each system versus the cost of each and review of the associated warranty, a new roof applied over the existing metal panels would provide the best value to Blinn College.

The proposed roofing system designed by Aestimo LLC is a single-ply PVC roof system. The design specifications call for a minimum 20-year Manufacturer's Warranty.

BUDGETARY CONSIDERATIONS:

The reroof project will be funded from Series 2014 bond funds.

Aestimo, Inc. (AESTIMO) has reviewed the following bids, which were submitted for the above-referenced project:

^{*} In a telephone conversation after the bid opening Regan Powell, of Schulte Roofing, indicated that the bid submitted by Schulte Roofing did not include the required Owner's Contingency of \$15,000.

On the basis of AESTIMO's review, the apparent low bidder for the project is United Roofing. United Roofing's bid equates to approximately \$6.81/SF for the Base Bid after the Owner's Contingency has been subtracted, which falls within AESTIMO's preliminary estimate for the project from 2013. To evaluate the qualifications of the Bidder and the responsiveness of the submitted bid, David Swords, of Aestimo and Shawn Welch, of Blinn College, contacted Ben Winkler, of United Roofing, the low bid Contractor, by telephone. In summary, Mr. Winkler demonstrated a thorough understanding of the project scope of work and indicated that the submitted bid was prepared in accordance with the project specification and drawings. In addition, Mr. Winkler provided a list of references from previous projects.

With respect to qualifications, AESTIMO has not worked with United Roofing; however, based on discussions with Mr. Billy Harkins, of Alpha Construction, and Mr. Michael Wilganowski, of St. Joseph Regional Health Center, United Roofing appears to be qualified and capable of performing the specified work. Mr. Harkins and Mr. Wilganowski reported that United Roofing has completed numerous roofing projects for them over the past 10 years and they are very satisfied with their work. With consideration to their low bid and their apparent qualifications for performing the work, AESTIMO recommends awarding the contract to United Roofing.
