## TXDOT Project on Sandy Point Road

Please place the following item on the Bryan City Council Regular Agenda for the regularly scheduled meeting of Mar 24, 2016:

Discussion, consideration, and possible action to direct staff to:

authorize city staff to select a design consultant to design the improvements for Sandy Point according to TXDOT's request (widen to three lanes with sidewalks, storm sewer, curb and gutter) from SH21 to end of County's property (estimated cost of construction \$1,000,000) and bring the design contract back to council for approval and to commit funding for the city's portion, \$250,000 (25% of total), as requested by TXDOT. This action should be completed as soon as possible but no-later-than the first council meeting in April 2016.
