PURPOSE

- The committee makes suggested changes the the dress code based on campus discipline data, safety concerns, impact on instruction and current/acceptable styles.

SHIRTS TUCKED INTO WAISTBAND

CURRENT RULE:

- Boys' shirts must be tucked into waistband in grades 6 – 12.

SUGGESTED CHANGE:

- Boys' shirts must be the length of an untucked shirt and must be no longer than the tip of the longest finger with the student's hand fully extended down the side of the student's leg.



MORE UNTUCKED SHIRTS



SHORTS & SKORTS

CURRENT RULE:

- Acceptable shorts and skorts must reach the top of the knee or longer.



SUGGESTED CHANGE:

- Acceptable length must be mid-thigh or longer.



DRESSES & SKIRTS

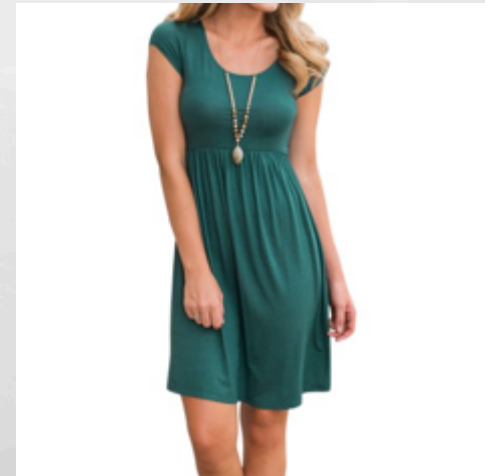
CURRENT RULE:

- Acceptable dresses and skirts must reach the top of the knee or longer. grades k-5 must reach mid-thigh or longer and be worn with shorts or leggings beneath.



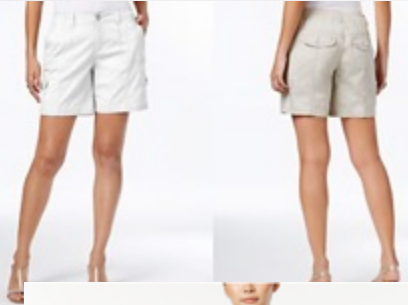
SUGGESTED CHANGE:
