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Fall District Contact Hours

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- Growth in Blinn’s high school dual credit
- Increase in enrollment for 12-week courses
 - Begin Monday, September 25
- Brenham continues to be flat in enrollment and contact hours
- Schulenburg up slightly in enrollment
- Larger number of first time, full-time students
- TEAM and Engineering Academy enrollment grew
 - TEAM – 990 students
 - Engineering Academy Bryan – 500
 - Engineering Academy Brenham - 81

- Loss of the federal prison
- Bryan decrease in enrollment could be due to the statewide trend of increased high school dual credit
- TAMU's fall 2017 admitted class is up more than 10% to almost 14,000
- Surprising decrease in enrollment and contact hours for Distance Learning classes
 - Had large increase last year
- Decrease in Spring enrollment, caused retained numbers to be lower

- RELLIS will provide opportunity
- New dorm will provide room to grow in Brenham
- Enrollment Management team meeting and coming up with ideas for increased enrollment
 - “What are we doing today to increase enrollment!”
- Recruiting initiatives
 - Surveying students who applied but did not attend
 - Increase in Engineering Academy
 - Agriculture and Performing Arts departmental recruiting
 - Potential increase in athletic redshirt programs
 - More targeted on-campus activities
