

House Bill 3 & Full Day Prekindergarten



House Bill 3

- Full day PreK **SHALL** be implemented for eligible students that are four years of age by September 1, 2019 for the 2019-20 school year.
- Two three-year waivers are available for lack of space but prior to seeking a waiver, district must solicit and consider proposals for partnerships with public and private entities.
- Prior to adding classrooms, district must consider outside providers.
- Early Childhood Allotment
 - Designed to cover funding for the second half of the day.

Teacher and full time assistant with an 11:1 student to teacher ratio.

A rigorous child-centered, developmentally appropriate, and multi-sensory experience.

Includes developmentally appropriate furniture and materials with fully integrated technology.

Breakfast and Lunch

We provide students with access to a variety of appealing foods that meet the state and federal health and nutrition requirements.

Transportation

Available for eligible students who live within the attending school's attendance zone and qualify for transportation services.

Increase the number of dates for centralized Registration.
