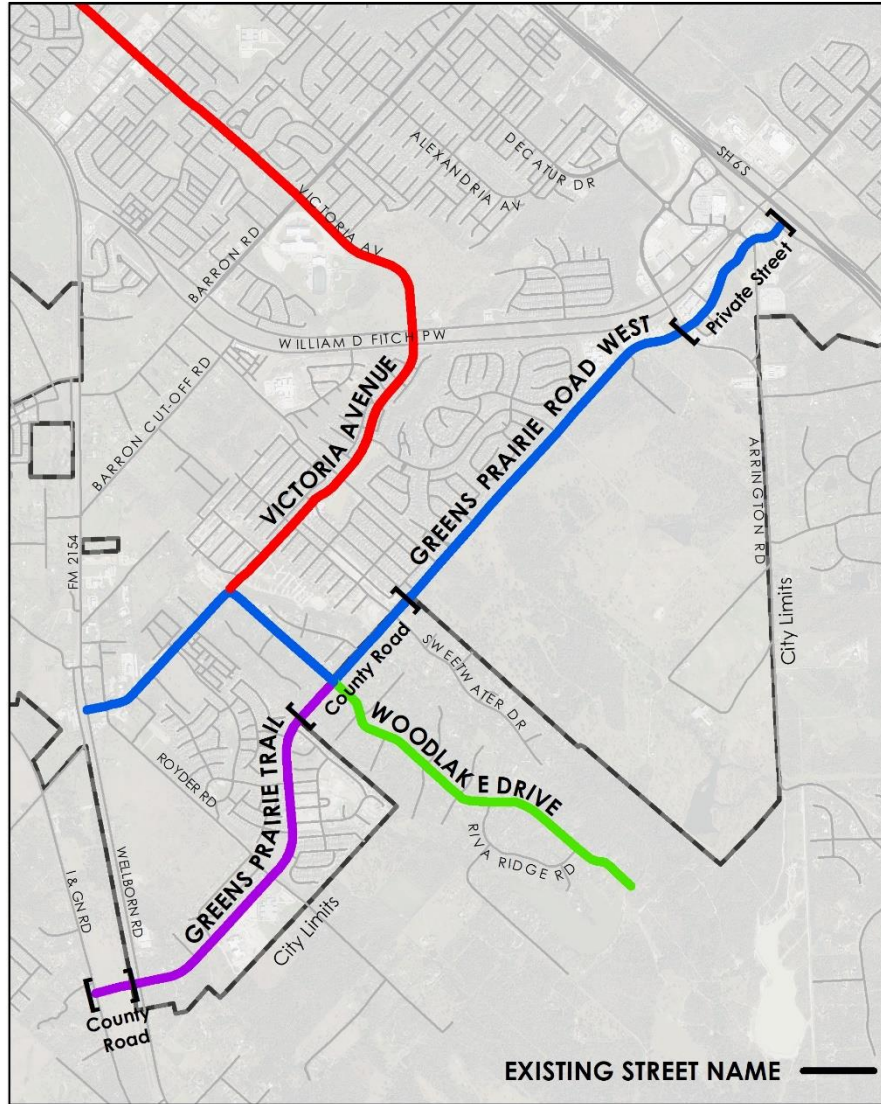
Potential Street Name Changes in Greens Prairie Road West Corridor



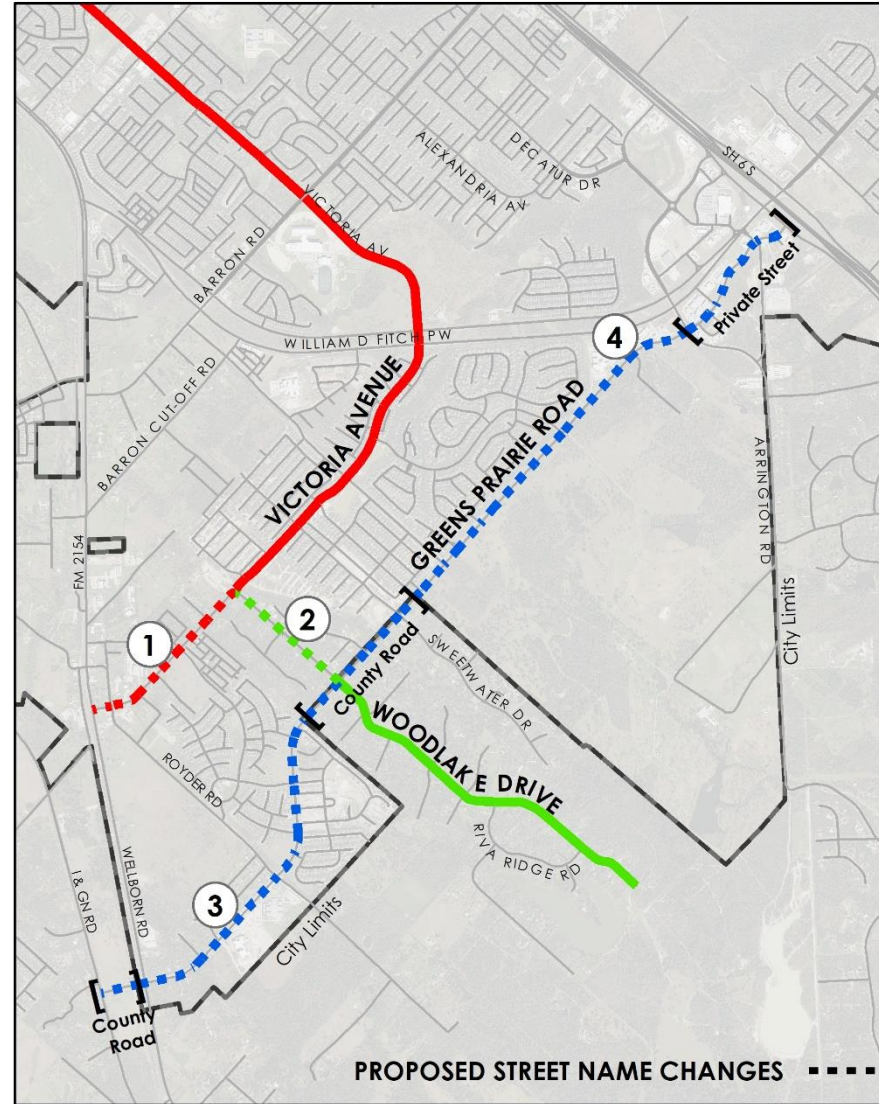
Proposal Process & Timeline

- Item developed in consultation with Brazos County 911. Purpose is to reduce confusion regarding street names for the traveling public and to enhance emergency response.
- As portion of some streets are located outside College Station City limits, those changes would need to be adopted jointly with Brazos County.
- May 3rd - College Station Traffic Management Team, a multi-department staff committee, recommended proceeding with the proposed street name changes.
- May 21st - College Station Council Transportation & Mobility Committee affirmed to continue forward with the proposal.
- June 11th - Presentation to Brazos County Commissioners Court.

Proposed Street Name Changes

- ① Greens Prairie Road West to Victoria Avenue - changing street name and street numbers
- ② Greens Prairie Road West to Woodlake Drive - changing street name only, no addresses affected
- ③ Greens Prairie Trail to Greens Prairie Road - changing street suffix only
- ④ Greens Prairie Road West to Greens Prairie Road - removing directional suffix only

Proposal Process & Timeline

- If Commissioners Court concurs, effort to rename all proposed streets will proceed.
- Notifications will be mailed to the affected addresses as well as courtesy notices to other stakeholders along the street corridors.
- The street renaming would be brought for formal adoption to the Brazos County Commissioners Court and College Station City Council later in summer 2019.
