ORDER LIFTING RESTRICTIONS ON OUTDOOR BURNING

WHEREAS, the Brazos County Commissioners Court ordered, at its August 13, 2019 regular called meeting, that restrictions on outdoor burning in the unincorporated areas of Brazos County, Texas, which are designated to become effective on August 13, 2019; and

WHEREAS, at the August 13, 2019 meeting, the Brazos County Commissioners Court determined that circumstances present in all or part of the unincorporated areas of Brazos County created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning; and

WHEREAS, at the August 13, 2019 meeting, the Brazos County Commissioners Court designated that the Brazos County Judge have the authority to terminate this Order in accordance with Local Government Code Section 352.081(c)(2); and

WHEREAS, the Brazos County Judge has considered the recent rains and determined that the circumstances present on August 13, 2019, in the unincorporated areas of Brazos County that created a public safety hazard that would be exacerbated by outdoor burning, no longer exist.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED by the Brazos County Judge that the previous order of August 13, 2019, which banned outdoor burning, is lifted and the restrictions set forth are removed until such time as the Brazos County Commissioners Court may take further action regarding the same.
