Summary:

The Heart of Texas Goodwill Industries, Inc. ("Goodwill"), wants to finance the construction and equipment for an approximately 25,000 square foot building located at 2710 Boonville Road, Bryan, Texas, to be used as a Goodwill store, job connection center, and a donation/processing center. Goodwill plans to finance the project in part through the issuance of a tax exempt note to be issued by the Mart Cultural Facilities Corporation (the "Mart Corporation"), in an aggregate maximum principal amount not to exceed \$5,000,000. On November 12, 2019, at 3:00 p.m., at the Bryan Goodwill facility at 2600 Texas Avenue, Bryan, Texas, Goodwill will have held the required public hearing regarding the financing.

State and federal regulations require that such a note be approved by the jurisdictions in which the project is located. Goodwill has requested the City's approval with regard to the issuance of the Note solely for the purpose of satisfying (i) the provisions of Section 147(f) of the <u>Internal Revenue Code</u> of 1986 as amended (which requires for tax purposes that the Note be approved by a jurisdiction in which the Project is located) and the requirements of Section 221.030(a)(1)(B) of the Texas Health and Safety Code (which requires the permission of the City for the Mart Corporation to exercise its powers for a project located within the City).

The City of Bryan will have no liability for either the project or repayment of the loan. Additionally, the approval sought is solely for the tax exempt loan and is not related to zoning, building permits, or any other form of approval the City of Bryan may require related to the construction of the Goodwill project. The Goodwill loan also will have no impact on Bryan's ability to issue tax exempt bonds.

Goodwill will request separate approval from Brazos County.

Staff Analysis and Recommendation:

Staff recommends approving the resolution, which provides consent to the issuance of a tax exempt note by Mart Cultural Facilities Corporation for the Heart Of Texas Goodwill Industries, Inc.
