

### **Financial Update**

- District maintains a strong financial position
- Aggressively paid down debt
- Strong Financial Ratings on past bonds
- Current Bonding Capacity at \$0.28 I & S Tax Rate
  - Approximately \$140 Million
- Potential Capacity at \$0.29 (or 1 cent increase) I&S Tax Rate
  - Approximately \$180 Million


- \$175 million bond plan

### **Tax Rate**

Estimated impact of 7/8ths (.875) of a penny tax rate increase on a Bryan ISD home at \$100,000 would be:


- \$8.75 per year
- \$ .73 per month

### **Tax Rate**

 Homestead taxes are frozen for our citizens with the Over 65 or Disabled Persons exemptions, unless the citizen is currently paying below their

tax ceiling.
