Overview of Reading Academies

Historical Overview

- Began in 2015 as a result of the 84th
 Texas Legislature
 - Bryan ISD has had a number of teachers participate during this time.
- HB 3 now mandates participation in professional development providing instruction on the Science of Teaching Reading which will be done through mandatory reading academies.

Parameters for Reading Academies

- All Teachers in grades K-3
 - Special Education Teachers included
 - Art, Music, PE on a waiver for 2020-2021 at this time.
- All Elementary Principals
- Training will take a total 10 days minimum of 80 hours
- Must be completed in a single school year (August - June)
- All Cohorts must be trained by the end of the 2022-2023 school year.



Reading Academy Models

There are two, competency-based models that provide local flexibility to meet the requirement in statute. Both blended and comprehensive models cover the same content.



Decision Point- Which model do we chose?

Comprehensive Model

\$3,000 per participant

vs

Blended Model

\$400 per participant


- Accessed through a Learning Management System
- Participants will be required to demonstrate understanding and application of concepts
- Current estimates of the training and completion of the required tasks for both models are a minimum of 80 hours per participant.



Option	Best for Districts that:	Positions Required	Final Cost
Serve as an Authorized Provider	Can support 1000+ teachers through academy completion	Staff to oversee process Cohort Leaders	Pay salaries for staff who will over process and for cohort leaders. Cohort Leaders (at minimum 4)
Utilize an Authorized	Cannot meet	None	Blended Model: \$400 per Persor



<u>Decision Point</u>- Which implementation option do we select?



Ineligible - We do not serve more than 1,000 K-3 Teachers



Cost: Ranges between \$185,000 - 1.5 million



Cost: Two positions + \$20,000

Timeline

• Applications submitted for Authorized Providers

Authorized Providers Trained in Austin

April 2020

Cohort Leader candidates notified if they are accepted

Cohort Leaders trained in Austin

May 2020

Initial Cohorts can begin Reading Academy Training.

Submit applications for Cohort Leader candidates (Locally Implemented)

July 2023

All Cohort Reading Academy Trainings must be completed

Decision Point-When do we begin?

Train all Participants in 2020-2021

Phase in over 3 Years: 2020-2023

 Under local implementation option with blended model - two Cohort Leaders to cover all 459 participants (K-4).

- Offer Cohorts over the three years with decisions about who to train when.
- As staff change campuses and grade level, the district would need to keep track of who has been trained and would send teachers to different PD opportunities based on who has completed the TEA mandated training.
