Background


- Bryan City Cemetery Expansion:
 - Expansion completed in December 2017
 - Provided 9,600 additional plots
 - Recent request to dedicate a portion of the new expansion for a Veterans section

Recommendations

- August 6th: Bryan Cemetery Advisory Board unanimously recommended establishing a Veterans section in the Bryan City Cemetery
- Staff Recommendation: Block 28 (882 individual plots)
- Double-stacking: Recommended for a Veteran's spouse (potentially provide space for 1,764 burials) – a standard in Veterans' cemeteries

Proposed Amendment to Cemetery Ordinance

- Block 28: Designate as Veterans section
- Restricts burials to Veterans who served and died while on active duty or after receiving an honorable discharge
- One plot per veteran; double-stacking allowed for spouse
- Headstones: Standard government issued upright headstones
- Plots: Non-transferable, but can be sold back to the City
- Flagpoles: Installed and maintained by the City





Next Steps and Timeline

- September 2020:
 - City Council consideration: Amendment to Chapter
 22 of the Cemetery Ordinance
 - Prepare Block 28 for sales
 - Open Veterans section
- Dedication Ceremony: November 11, Veterans Day (tentative)
