

- Discussed possible considerations for the use of bond savings & contingency, including Fine Arts safety repairs,
- May 22, 2020 Oversight Meeting
 - Agreed to allocate bond savings for Fine Arts facility safety repairs for an estimated need of \$850,000.00
 - Contract Amount: \$420,654.60 for phase one
 - Contract amount for phase two is to be determined

Fine Arts Repair Status

Repair Timeline

- Bryan ISD PAC Project started August 17, 2020
- Anticipated completion is November 30, 2020
- Rudder PAC curtain replacement to begin in 4-5 weeks

- Next phase at Bryan PAC is removal of existing equipment
- Replacement of fire hatch rope .
 - Rope will be replaced with wire this will prevent hatches from leaking.



BRYAN ISD TAX RATE HISTORY & PROJECTED



REQUIRED LANGUAGE

- As part of House Bill 3 (HB3) passed by the 86th Texas Legislature in 2019, all ballot language for school bond elections MUST include the statement "This is a property tax increase".
- However, the Bryan ISD 2020 Bond will NOT increase the district's current tax rate.
