## Waste Hauler Agreements

#### Private Waste Hauler

 The City Charter (and SW Ordinance) prohibited the private collection of waste, unless permitted by the City.

Private waste haulers are required to be permitted through an agreement.

 Permits can only be obtained for materials not collected by the City or where the City cannot provide adequate container size (e.g. roll off containers, compactors, and recycling services).

### Summary of Agreement

- Contractor may provide roll off, compactor, or recycling services
- Collected material must be secured and covered
- Recycling material must be place in a secure bag or container
- Quarterly reports shall be submitted
- Equipment shall be properly maintained
- All complaints must be resolved within 24hrs
- Contractor will pay the City quarterly either \$500/vehicle or 6% of gross hauling revenue (which ever is greater)

#### Solid Waste Ordinance

#### **ARTICLE V. AUTHORIZATIONS AND PERMITS**

Sections 102-83. Current Agreement with City Required.

No waste hauler permit shall be issued to a person, unless the person has a current, executed agreement with the City, approved by the City Council, to provide waste hauler services. To insure the most effective and efficient regulation, collection and disposal of solid waste and to protect the public health, safety and welfare, the City Council, may, in its discretion, elect to enter into an agreement with one or more persons selected by the City Council to provide waste hauler services under terms and conditions established by the City Council. The waste hauler agreement shall provide for early termination in accordance with the provisions of Sections 102-87 and 102-88. The City may at its discretion deny any and all waste hauler permits.
