## 2021-2022 Middle School / High School Daily Schedule

### Timeline

July 2020	Pandemic Response: switch to block schedule with early release  
October 2020	Discussion with MS/HS principals regarding block schedule and 8-period day
October 2020	The District Scheduling Team begins meeting weekly to discuss scheduling impact, options, and considerations. Representation from School Leadership, Fine Arts, CTE, Athletics, Teaching & Learning, Human Resources, etc.
November 2020	Fall Survey of Staff, Parents, and Students - open ended questions regarding scheduling pros and cons
November	Board of Trustees approves purchase of Cardonex
Dec. - Feb	Student Registration
Feb - March	Campus administration meets with campus department chairs and team leaders to discuss options as well as pros and cons
April	Campus Principals and District Scheduling Team meet to discuss master schedule design for 20-21

1 Planning or 1 plan/1 PLC for STAAR Tested Courses

**Planning/Conference State Requirement 450 minutes over 2 weeks**, w/ ea. period a minimum of 45.

- Planning under Traditional 8 period day over 2 weeks:  $47 \times 10 = 470$  minutes
- Planning under proposed schedule::  $47 \times 6 + 98 \times 2 = 478$  minutes  
*{These are approximate planning times (will vary by campus based on passing periods and lunch schedules)}*

- Allows for 4 class meetings each week: compromise for traditional and block
- Allows for 4 planning/conference periods each week
- Keeps days/minutes balanced for the alternating days
