

- They may need additional support in their pursuit of post-secondary opportunities.
- They may be historically underserved students, such as students who are at-risk and/or economically disadvantaged.

- A smaller environment
- Increased mentoring and progress monitoring toward graduation
- Personalized college and career planning
- Flexibility and opportunity to accelerate
- An 8 period block course schedule & 50 minute advisory period

The CVHS Academies

Collegiate Academy

Currently, students can earn up to 55 hours of dual credit STEM/42 non-STEM through Blinn College

Career & Industry Academy

Earn an industry-based certification while completing a program of study not offered at the comprehensive high schools

Accelerated Academy

Earn a foundation high school diploma with endorsement (26 credits) at an accelerated pace through a custom graduation plan that includes in-person and Edgenuity courses



Collegiate Academy

In the 2021-22 School Year:

Continue current dual credit offerings

Future Plans:

- Streamline dual credit offerings to lead to an associate's degree
- Explore partnerships with universities and technical colleges to build an avenue to pursue a four-year degree in two years after high school graduation



Accelerated Academy

Add Program for the 2021-22 School Year:

 Recruit students who desire to accelerate learning for initial credit and/or learning recovery

• Students who desire early graduation in 3-3.5 years.
