COMMITTEE METHODOLOGY GY

Background:

College Station ISD (CSISD) has determined that while new facilities are not recommended at this time, there are other projects and equipment normally funded with bonded indebtedness with an immediate need.

Committee Purpose:

The purpose of the 2021 Bond Planning Committee is to review CSISD's need for a bond referendum to support the district in areas including but not limited to: facility renovations, deferred maintenance, buses, fine arts, land acquisition, technology, and other potential capital needs.

Committee Responsibilities:

Based on the review of the CSISD debt capacity and needs described above, the Bond Planning Committee will make a recommendation to the Board of Trustees on whether to pursue a bond election, potential timing of a bond election and potential projects to be included in this bond program.


