^{**} Even though state aide was supplanted, CSISD was able to carryforward \$1,072,337 to the 2020-2021 fiscal year to assist with the unexpected impact to the General Fund due to COVID 19.



ESSER I Uses

- Reimburse the Food Service fund for lost revenue and retain a positive fund balance
- COVID 19 related expenses
- Technology
- Extra duty pay
- Tutoring
- Additional labor
- Instructional supplies


It is anticipated these funds will be exhausted by August 31, 2021.

ESSER III

Fund purpose:

To help safely reopen and sustain the safe operations of schools while addressing the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students.

Timeline of events:





ESSER III Requirements

Must expend a minimum of 20% on the following:

- Evidenced-based interventions, such as summer learning, extended day and comprehensive after-school programs or extended year programs; and
- Ensure interventions respond to students' academic, social and emotional needs and address disproportionate impact of coronavirus on Title 1, homeless, and foster student populations.

Engage in meaningful consultation, engage stakeholders, and give the opportunity for the public to provide input on the development of the plan.

Review of the plan every 6 months seeking stakeholder input and if appropriate revise the plan throughout the grant period.



ESSER III Posting Requirements

- ➤ Notify the public of the intent to apply for the grant and how to provide input. (June 8th website, social media & newspaper)
- ➤ Post on the District's website within 30 days of receiving the grant "Notice of Grant Award" (NOGA).
- ➤ Report in the ESSER III applications for funding the website address (TEA will monitor this site throughout the grant for required postings and content.)

Consideration of Retention of Staff

The pandemic has caused considerable disruption to school operations and student learning starting with March of 2020 and throughout the 2020-2021 school year.

ALL CSISD staff are crucial to the successful operations in these unprecedented times.

These additional burdens are expected to last throughout the 2021-2022 school year and beyond.

The retention of staff throughout this process is essential in providing knowledge and consistency. One way to address this is through retention stipends.



Consideration of Retention of Staff

The payment of retention stipends to staff that were employed during the 2020-2021 year are allowable expenses in ESSER I, II and III as well as the General Fund.

With staff retention as a priority, it is anticipated CSISD administration will be requesting approval of a one-time stipend to ALL staff at the July board meeting.
