Bryan ISD Virtual Academy Open to All Students Living in Bryan ISD Attendance Area

Bryan ISD is exploring the possibility of opening up a virtual academy for Kindergarten - 6th grade, and is seeking interest from all families living in the Bryan ISD attendance area, even if the child does not currently attend a Bryan ISD school.

If accepted, students will learn from certified Bryan ISD teachers on Bryan ISD's highly recognized, rigorous curriculum. Learning will take place in a virtual environment, but will be synchronous, meaning students will be expected to follow a set schedule each day and will learn in real time, with some asynchronous activities also utilised.
