Summary:

Per the terms in the BioCorridor Interlocal Agreement between the City of Bryan and City of College Station, each city must consent to incentives offered by the other city. This consent does not commit any portion of Bryan's revenues generated per the revenue sharing agreement.

This resolution provides Bryan's support for the Economic Development Agreement between the City of College Station and Fujifilm Diosynth Biotechnologies Texas, LLC for the 138,000 square foot facility expansion located at 3939 Biomedical Way. This project is anticipated to generate approximately \$300,000,000 in investment and 150 new full time positions.

Staff Analysis and Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the proposed resolution consenting to the incentives offered by the City of College Station to Fujifilm Diosynth Biotechnologies Texas. The community is positioned for growth in the BioCorridor, and this project will serve to continue job growth and economic development on Bryan's west side.
