-Three (3) plans designed (Plan A, B, and C)






### Cost per Design Plan (without FF&E, technology, exterior)


- Plan A (Like-Kind)
  - -Total Cost: \$4,598,003 -City's Portion: \$534,121 (\$1.5M budgeted)
- Plan B (Extensive Renovation)
  - -Total Cost: \$7,139,452
    - -City's Portion: \$2,541,449 (\$1.5M budgeted)
- Plan C (Enhanced Plan A)
  - -Total Cost: \$5,253,719
  - -City's Portion: \$1,137,065 (\$1.5M budgeted)
