## **Summary:**

Mayor Gutierrez requested the preparation of this agenda item for the City Council's consideration. His suggestion, included on the attached resolution, is that attendance requirements for quasi-judicial board, committee, or commission appointees be eighty percent (80%) in any given six-month period. His suggestion for advisory boards and committees is sixty-six percent (66%) attendance in any given six-month period (the same as current policy). The resolution also sets out that appointees who do not meet the attendance requirements as established by this resolution will be removed unless an exception is granted by the City Council.

The adoption of this resolution will rescind Resolution No. 1641 adopted on November 23, 1987, establishing attendance requirements for all panels as 66 percent.

#### **Staff Analysis and Recommendation:**

Staff prepared this agenda item and resolution at the Mayor's request. If the City Council adopt this resolution, staff liaisons will be requested to inform all board, committee, and commission members of the revised attendance requirements. A copy of this resolution will be included with appointment letters to appointees. Staff is asked to inform the City Secretary's Office should an appointee fall below the attendance requirements.
