Consider approval of award of the A&M Consolidated High School Renovations

Phase 2 project to RAVA Construction in the amount of \$5,060,000 utilizing

2021 Bond Funds.

BACKGROUND

In November 2021, College Station ISD voters passed a bond issue for \$78.125 million for renovations to district facilities and other items. One project that has been identified as a significant need is renovations to A&M Consolidated High School. This agenda item is for the second phase of that work which would renovate the entire Principal's Office suite area, the Auditorium, and all of the classrooms on the first and second floor of the Science wing of the building. The project also includes work to reconfigure and harden the security vestibule and replace existing lighting with LED lighting inside and in the parking lot and create two additional science labs from other spaces.

VLK Architects prepared design documents and specifications for this work after coordination meetings with AMCHS Principal Gwen Elder, Chief Financial Officer Amy Drozd, Executive Director of Secondary Education Tiffany Parkerson, Executive Director of Facilities Jon Hall, and Assistant Director of Facilities Rene Ramirez.

This project is being processed as Competitive Sealed Proposal (CSP), so the project was advertised as required by statute and proposals were received on February 23, 2023 for the specified scope of work as per our design documents and scoring criteria was included in this information. Two proposals were received that day, the lowest of which was submitted by RAVA Construction in the amount of \$5,060,000. Dudley Construction also submitted a proposal for \$6,350,000. One alternate for the complete renovation of the Culinary Arts kitchen was considered, but not accepted as it was significantly higher than our budget for that portion of work.

The proposals were scored according to the provided criteria and tabulated by Executive Director of Facilities Jon Hall, Director of Purchasing Carmella Shafer, and VLK Architect Melissa Fleming. The best score was received by RAVA Construction with a final score of 95.7. Please see attached bid tab, VLK recommendation letter and scoring sheet for reference.



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This work would be scheduled for the summer of 2023 so that everything would be fully operational again by the start of school.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees consider approval of award of the A&M Consolidated High School Renovations Phase 2 project to RAVA Construction in the amount of \$5,060,000 utilizing 2021 Bond Funds.



On Thursday, February 23, 2023, Competitive Sealed Proposals were received at the College Station Independent School District's Purchasing Department Building for the AMCHS Renovations – Phase II project. Two (2) General Contractors submitted proposals; each Proposal is summarized on the attached Proposal Tabulation form.

Based on a review of the submitted proposals and accompanying proposal bond, and after evaluation of the proposals based on the published criteria in Division 00 – Procurement and Contracting Requirements of the specifications, per Education Code Chapter 44 and SB 669, and per our meeting with the evaluation committee, VLK Architects hereby recommends that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees award the construction contract to RAVA Construction, LLC, based on them having the highest score per the published criteria. VLK Architects recommends acceptance of the Base Proposal in the amount of Five Million, Sixty Thousand Dollars (\$5,060,000.00).

RAVA Construction, LLC is a Houston-area based general contractor with extensive experience on educational facilities, including several for College Station ISD. They are well qualified to execute the requirements of this contract.
