Subject: Consider approval of award of the Natatorium Renovations project to Marek

Brothers Construction in the amount of \$2,100,000 utilizing 2021 Bond Funds.

BACKGROUND

In November 2021, College Station ISD voters passed a bond issue for \$78.125 million for renovations to district facilities and other items. Specifically, Proposition D for \$2,969,270 was passed exclusively for the renovation of the Natatorium facility, which is part of the College Station Middle School campus.

VLK Architects prepared design documents and specifications for this work after coordination meetings with Athletic Director Kevin Starnes, Assistant Athletic Director Megan Symank, Tiger Swim Coach Jenny Marquardt, and Executive Director of Facilities Jon Hall.

This project is being processed as purchasing cooperative bid project. Proposals were solicited from four approved purchasing cooperative members, namely SpawGlass Construction, Aggieland Construction, RAVA Construction, and Marek Brothers Construction. Bid day was March 2, 2023, and three of the firms submitted proposals at that time. Results were as follows:

\$2,515,000 **Aggieland Construction** Marek Brothers Construction \$2,100,000 **RAVA Construction** \$2,696,000

After receiving these proposals, they were reviewed by Executive Director of Facilities Jon Hall, Assistant Director of Facilities Rene Ramirez and VLK Architect Melissa Fleming to confirm that each proposal was complete with all required scope covered as per our design documents. All three proposals were complete without exception.

Based on that review, the best value for the district was determined to be the proposal from Marek Brothers Construction for \$2,100,000. Please see recommendation letter from VLK Architects and the three proposals from Marek Brothers Construction, Aggieland Construction, and RAVA Construction attached for reference.



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This is well within our remaining budget for construction of \$2,525,640 after previously spending \$165,048 on a boiler replacement for that facility already.

This project would commence in April of 2023 and continue through the summer until completion early in the fall semester.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the College Station Independent School District Board of Trustees consider approval of award of the Natatorium Renovations project to Marek Brothers Construction in the amount of \$2,100,000 utilizing 2021 Bond Funds.


