Disability Resources staff members interact and collaborate with faculty, staff, and students to achieve an equitable learning environment for students with disabilities at Texas A&M University.




Responsibilities of Disability Resources

- Determine accommodations and address challenges students experience
- Collaborate with faculty to address accessibility issues
- Assistive technology assessment and provision
- Providing testing accommodations- Disability Resources Testing Center (DRTC)
- Managing sign language interpreting and transcription for academic purposes

Internal Challenges

- Continued increase in the number of students with accommodations
- More complicated accommodation requests- modified attendance, remote classes, etc.
- Staffing shortages (both student assistants and full-time staff)
- Lack of adequate space- both for administrative tasks and for students to test



External Challenges

- Large number of instructors served
- Lack of understanding of shared responsibility
- Exams not received in timely manner (extensive staff time tracking down exams)
- Instructors with specialized instructions for exam administration



Addressing the Challenges

- Changed final exams check-in process for most finals
- Provided information to instructors at beginning of semester
- External Review and University Working Group
- Examining Testing Center staffing
- Satellite testing centers?
- Education for instructors
- Proactive approach to inclusive class design
