Brazos County, and Texas A&M University to purchase a rescue vehicle with Bryan's share of the

cost being the amount of \$80,173.75

#### **Summary:**

Consideration for the City Council to authorize the Mayor to execute an Interlocal Agreement between the City of College Station, City of Bryan, Brazos County, and Texas A&M University authorizing the purchase of a rescue vehicle. The cost of the purchase will be shared equally among the four entities, \$80,173.75 each, payment upon delivery. City of College Station will purchase the vehicle and hold the title in its name. The Interlocal Agreement spells out the processes and procedures for maintenance, repairs, training, and requesting use of the rescue vehicle. Total cost of the rescue vehicle is \$320,695.

Approval of the Interlocal Agreement will provide authorization for the City of College Station to place the order for the rescue vehicle.

### **Staff Analysis and Recommendation:**

The rescue vehicle is defined as a custom tactical armored vehicle for special operations units and tactical teams to use for responding to active shooter scenarios, barricaded suspects, response and rescue, and high-risk warrants.

The Bryan Police Department recommends approving the Interlocal Agreement authorizing the purchase of the rescue vehicle, maintenance, training, and use of the rescue vehicle. Approval will require funds in the amount of \$80,173.75 to cover the City of Bryan's equal portion of the purchase of the rescue vehicle upon delivery. Total cost of the rescue vehicle is \$320,695.

### **Options:**

- 1. Approve and sign the Interlocal Agreement.
- 2. Do not approve the Interlocal Agreement and provide guidance to staff.
