Ordinance Amending Chapter 8 Itinerant Vendors as Charitable Organizations





Ch. 8 Itinerant Vendors as Charitable Organizations

- a. The current ordinance contains exemption language related to charitable organizations that removes all regulations and enforcement options.
- b. Charitable organizations will still be exempt from the application process, permitting, and fees.
- c. From a safety standpoint, the desired result is to prevent public spaces, alleys, promenades, and sidewalks from becoming obstructed. This will help avoid concentrating intoxicated individuals, which lead to fights and assaults.
- d. The suggested changes will create operational consistencies between charitable organizations and other itinerant vendors in the City.



Ch. 8 Itinerant Vendors as Charitable Organizations

- a. A charitable organization is exempt from the application, permit, permit fee, and bonds required of itinerant vendors.
- b. A charitable organization must follow all other itinerant vendor regulations.
- c. No itinerant vendor or charitable organization may operate between the hours of 2 a.m. to 5 a.m. in the Northgate District.
- d. No itinerant vendor or charitable organization may locate or operate in or on any street, sidewalk, right-of-way, promenade, parking garage, parking lot, or any other City owned, leased, or operated property without the express written consent of the City Manager.
