


Northgate Outdoor Dining Details

- The police department is recommending repealing the Outdoor
 Dining Ordinance in Northgate.
- The physical barriers were intended to create an environment for outdoor dining; however, this is not how they are used.
- The physical barriers inhibit the emergency response of police and fire resources and concentrate intoxicated individuals, leading to fights and assaults.
- The physical barriers create environmental congestion that limits the safe pass through by those trying to get to TAMU campus.
- From a Northgate safety standpoint, the desired result is to openup the public space, to maximize pedestrian flow and minimize congestion.
