 - Established routine meetings



- By the numbers
 - Students 77,491 (78% undergraduate)
 - Faculty 4,173 (Tenured/Tenure-Track: 2,049, Non-Tenure Track: 2,124)
 - Staff 8,197
- Total endowment growth
 - Current Endowment is around \$18 billion (44% growth in the past 5 years)
- Annual budget
 - Current Annual Budget is \$2.64 billion (36% growth in the past 5 years)


