SCHOOL HEALTH ADVISORY COUNCIL (SHAC)

Every Independent School District is required by law to have a <u>School Health Advisory Council (SHAC)</u> of which the majority of members must be parents who are not employed by the school district. The SHAC is annually appointed by the local education agency Board of Trustees. All CSISD Administrators are invited to submit names to serve on SHAC. This group has met five times this year (min. Of four required) throughout the school year 2023-2024.


The Whole School, Whole Community, Whole Child (WSCC) model

CELL PHONE AND ELECTRONICS

- 97% of 11-18 year olds use their phones during the school day on average for 45-mins per school day (Common Sense Media Survey, 2023)
- On average students pick-up their phones during the school day 51 times (range was 2-498 times) (Common Sense Media Survey, 2023)
- 77% of school districts across the country have added rules to prohibit the use of devices for non-educational purposes (Nat. Center for Education Statistics)

For CSISD, continue to look at and evaluate cell phone policies to limit distractions/off-task behavior during instructional times.



SAFE STREETS FOR ALL INITIATIVE

- Community members expressed concerns for the safety of students & families wanting to ride their bikes to school.
- Safe Streets for all is a federal grant-based program to improve safety on roads and streets through safer people, roads, and vehicles.
- Discussed bike lanes on roads currently being used for drop-off/pick-up lines and how to keep those areas clear for bikers
- Recommended they appeal to the city to address issues since the roads are theirs

For CSISD, recommend to have a plan to ensure safety of students arriving/leaving school on bikes



2023-2024 SHAC RECOMMENDATION

SHAC recommends that CSISD develop, distribute in the employee handbook, and enforce a policy to limit the screening of paid video advertising presented by any faculty, staff, or substitute member of the district CSISD students during school hours or in the classroom.
