Timeline

- 7/13/23 Removed parking from the south side of Ponderosa Drive
- 7/27/23 Discussed citywide proposal to address commercial vehicle street parking
- 8/30/23 Held public meeting to obtain feedback on commercial vehicle street parking
- 11/9/23 Received Council direction to prohibit commercial vehicle street parking



Current Ordinance and Enforcement

- Commercial vehicle definition
 - a motor vehicle or combination weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds, including a towed unit with a gross vehicle weight or a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 10,000 pounds; or has a gross vehicle weight or gross vehicle weight rating of 26,001 or more pounds
- Commercial vehicle parking complaints and citations from code enforcement (1/1/2022 to 3/1/2024)
 - 37 complaints on SeeClickFix
 - 44 warnings
 - 12 citations

Public Education

- Parking prohibition would not be enforced until October 1, 2024, allowing for public notification and education
 - Blog and website postings
 - PSA video on Channel 19 and social media posts
 - Temporary signs linked to information website
 - Windshield flyers at high volume locations
 - Utilize message boards
 - Direct communication with trucking community



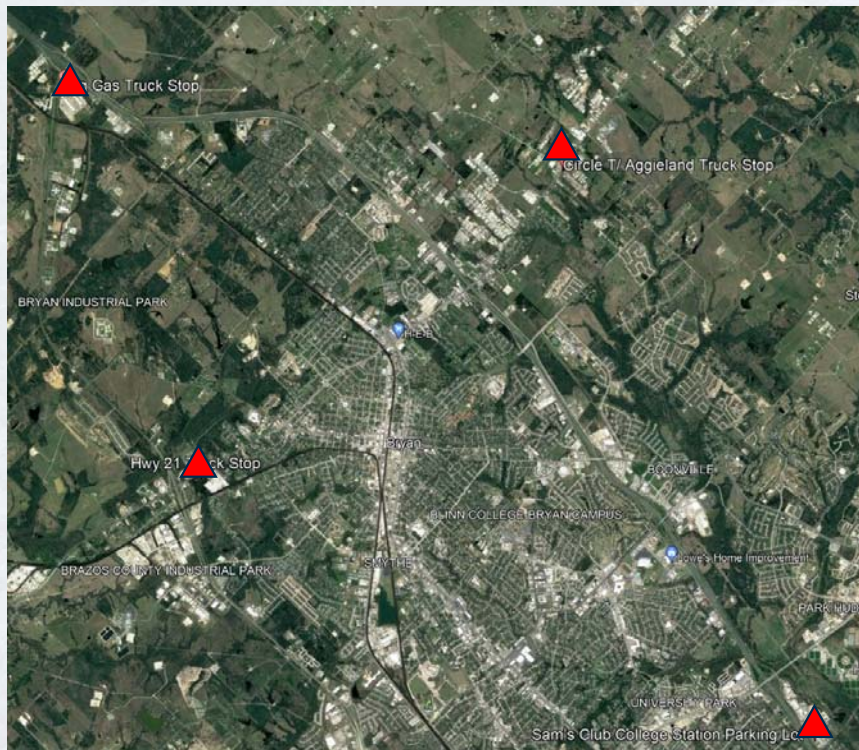
Regular Item 9.3

- Ordinance Amending
 - Chapter 38, Article II, Section 38-45;
 - and Repeal Chapter 38, Article VI, Section 38-1016
