Civil Violation, Presumptions, and Defenses

- → The violation is that it is unlawful for a responsible person to allow or have in a ROO a family of more than two unrelated person occupying a single-family dwelling unit.
- → Rebuttable Presumptions
- → Residence as Evidence
- → Affirmative Defenses

Chapter 26 Sec. 26-14

- \rightarrow Sec. 26-14: Civil ordinance with set fines
 - \rightarrow The administrative penalty is :
 - \rightarrow \$250 dollars for the first violation.
 - \rightarrow \$350 dollars for the second violation.
 - \rightarrow \$500 dollars for three or more violations.
 - → An administrative penalty may be assessed for each day a violation continues.
- → Administrative citation or notice
- → Administrative Hearing and Appeal
