- Scofflaw definition: a vehicle owner
  who has an outstanding warrant for
  failure to appear or failure to pay a fine
  on a complaint that involves the
  violation of a traffic law
- Transportation Code Section 702.003.
   Refusal to Register Vehicle

- Sec. 702.003 (a). A county assessorcollector or the department may refuse to register a motor vehicle...
- Sec. 702.003(b). A municipality may contract with a county in which the municipality is located or the department...

- Sec. 702.001(1) "Department" means the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles.
- Sec. 702.003(e). A contract under Subsection (b) must be entered into in accordance with Chapter 791, Government Code... (Interlocal Cooperation Contracts)

- Purpose of the Program is enforcement of Certain Arrest Warrants
- Only applies to registered owners of a motor vehicle with outstanding warrants for violation of a traffic law

- Approximately 10,600 outstanding warrants
- ~6400 Capias Pro Fines totaling \$3.1M
- ~4200 Warrants of arrest totaling \$2.1M
- As of May 17, 2024 there were 5,171 cases eligible to be sent for probing

- Partnership with our collection vendor
- In August 2023, the City entered into a contract with McCreary, Veselka, Bragg & Allen PC (MVBA) for the collection of delinquent fines and fees
- Scofflaw Program is another tool used to collect

- MVBA will absorb all costs as a part of their enhanced services to utilize this tool
- The Contract with the Department requires a deposit to cover costs (paid for by MVBA)
- MVBA administers Scofflaw program on behalf of the City (requires MOU)

- Once case is flagged with the Department, the registration may be refused (soft stop)
- Hard stop for online renewal
- Notice to the registered owner that money is owed or they failed to appear

- When case is resolved, MVBA will send notice to the Department to no longer deny the registration
- Benefit to this enforcement tool is that vehicle registration is every year

- City must submit Scofflaw contract to the DMV (5 year contract)
- City must enter into MOU with MVBA
- MVBA will conduct the program on behalf of the City
- MVBA pays for all costs (NO cost to the City or additional costs to defendant)
