Summary:

Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone (TIRZ) #21 is generally described as Downtown Bryan and was created by petition on December 14, 2006. Brazos County recently approved an Interlocal Agreement for limited participation in the zone. The termination of the zone is scheduled to occur on or before December 31, 2041.

The proposed amendment includes additional Project Costs in an amount not to exceed 1) \$14,000,000.00 for the Downtown North area for costs associated with infrastructure including publicly accessible structured and underground parking, parks and play areas, updates to existing roadways, updates to and construction of sidewalks and pathways, landscaping, lighting, and upgrades to and/or relocation of electrical lines, water lines, sewer lines, and storm sewer currently located within the public right-of-way and 2) \$3,500,000 for the Lorca Development area for costs associated with publicly accessible structured and surface parking and façade upgrades beyond what is required by the currently adopted building codes and site development codes.

These Project Costs will further be defined and regulated through Chapter 380 Agreements to be approved by the City Council at a later date.

Staff Analysis and Recommendation:

The TIRZ #21 Board of Directors approved this amendment on September 19, 2024. To facilitate continued growth and redevelopment of Downtown Bryan, staff recommends approval of this amendment.
