Party Smart education

- **2023-2024 academic year:**

- OCSS staff and City partners distributed Party Smart Packs to more than 700 homes in College Station
- More than 50 students attended a Party Smart event shortly before Spring Break to learn about safety, host responsibility, risk management, student conduct expectations, and alcohol laws

- **Fall 2024**

- Party Smart Pack distribution continues based on loud party call data provided by City partners
- More than 140 participants attended the Party Smart Watch Party during the football game against Mississippi State


