

RESOLUTION DELEGATING PURCHASING AUTHORITHY TO RESPOND TO AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, On December 4, 2024, a fire suppression line ruptured at Pebble Creek Elementary School causing significant flooding to a portion of the campus. In order to resume classes, the District had to work swiftly to hire a commercial restoration company to clean up water and the damage resulting from the burst water line. In addition, a Fire Suppressant Company needed to be hired to repair the line.

WHEREAS, Pursuant to Board Policy CH (LOCAL), the Board has delegated authority to the Superintendent to make budgeted purchases of goods and services costing less than \$50,000.

WHEREAS, the emergency described above may make it difficult or impossible for the board to approve purchase in excess of the amount delegated in Board Policy CH(LOCAL) in a timely and efficient manner.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of College Station Independent School District authorizes the Superintendent or designee, the authority to make budgeted purchases of goods and services as necessary to continue district operations during the duration of the emergency.

The Superintendent shall inform the Board of any such approved purchases at the next board meeting for ratification by the board.

Unless otherwise terminated by the board, the authority granted by this resolution shall apply as long as the emergency conditions make it difficult for the board to approve purchases.
