The majority of calls involving mental health consumers are taken by patrol officers.

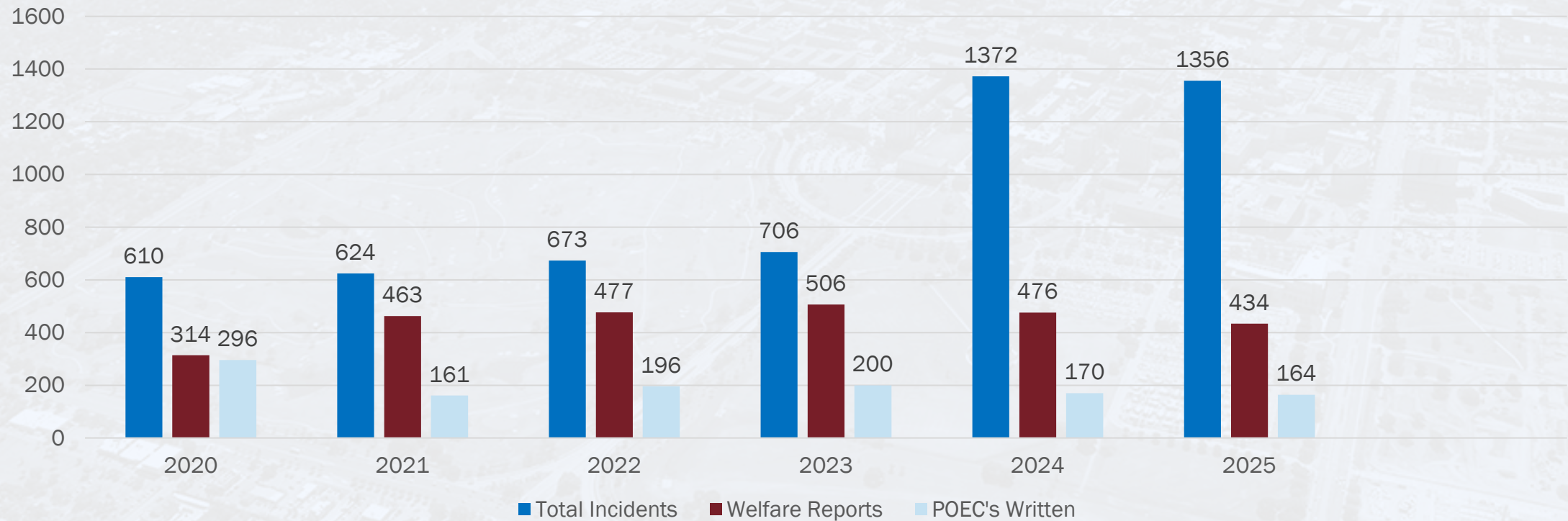
Crisis Intervention Team members are further trained as certified Mental Health Peace Officers

These officers respond to a handle the more unique or challenging calls involving mental health consumers.



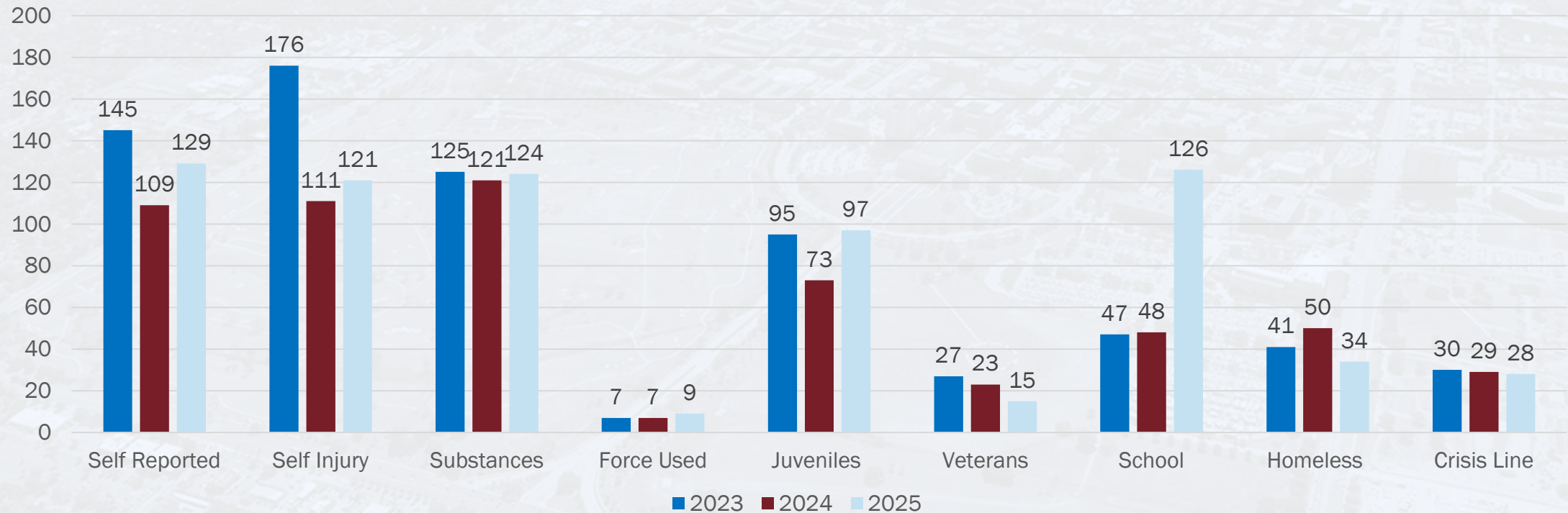

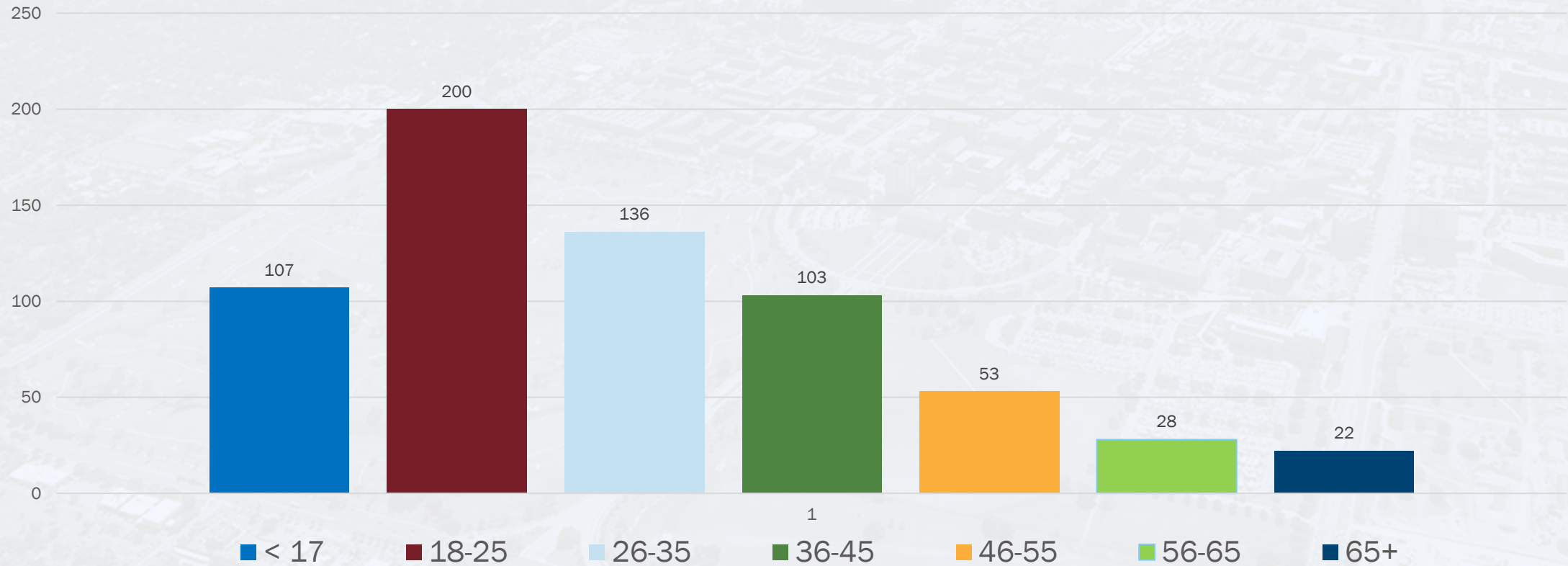
Crisis Intervention Calls for Service

2023-2025 Totals

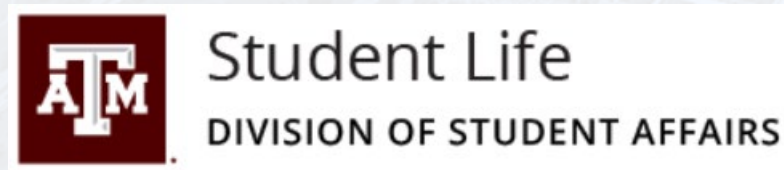


Crisis Intervention Calls for Service
