### Summary:

On November 14, 2023, the City Council approved Resolution No. 4071 and a Multiple Use Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) to mount four (4) automated license plate readers (ALPR) cameras within TxDOT right-of-way. The attached amendment to Resolution No. 4071 authorizes the installation of five (5) additional ALPR Cameras within the TxDOT right-of-way. The five additional ALPR cameras were not authorized under the original Multiple Use Agreement.

### Staff Analysis and Recommendation:

The Bryan Police Department purchased five ALPR cameras in Fiscal Year 2026. The purchased equipment recently arrived, and a deployment plan was developed by the Bryan Police Department in coordination with Flock Safety, the vendor for the APLR. To maximize ALPR coverage around the perimeter of the City of Bryan, five cameras will need to be located within TxDOT right-of-way.

The attached Amendment to Resolution No. 4071 specifies the locations the City and State agree to add to the existing Multiple Use Agreement. In all other respects, the Agreement remains in force and effect without change.

The Bryan Police Department recommends approval of the proposed amendment to the Multiple Use Agreement within Resolution No. 4071 allowing Flock Safety to mount cameras at five specified TxDOT right-of-way locations.

### Options:

1. Approve and execute the proposed Amendment to Resolution No. 4071.
2. Do not approve the proposed Amendment and provide guidance to staff.
