Location

- E 29th Street
 - Begin: Carter Creek Parkway
 - End: Autumn Circle (College Station)
 - East side of roadway (KBTX)
- Crossing Burton Creek



Background

- Mitchell & Morgan awarded original design contract in April of 2018 in anticipation of receiving funding from TxDOT Transportation Alternatives Set Aside (TASA) program
- TxDOT TASA program funded restricted to State roadways only which eliminated the opportunity to utilize funds on 29th St
- Design plans completed and shelved in 2019
 - To be updated by original design firm
- City of Bryan applied for Category 9 Funding through Bryan College Station Municipal Planning Organization (BCSMPO) in 2025 and was awarded funding
 - Awarded \$1,523,000 by the MPO as part of a competitively selection

Agreement Details and Cost

- Project Construction must begin by Q1 2027
 - Construction will be let out for bid and managed by the local TxDOT office.
- Federal funding provided = \$1,523,000
- City participation = \$380,750 (this is an estimate, final participation amount will be based on true construction cost)
 - First payment to the State is due within 30 days of AFA being executed
 - Second payment due within 60 days prior to construction contract being advertised for bids (estimated February 2027)
- The City of Bryan will be responsible for 100% of any monetary cost over the original bid price of construction including change orders, material overages, market price increases, redesign, etc. (final cost of overages typically provided after project completion)
