A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF AN ADVANCE FUNDING AGREEMENT (AFA) WITH THE TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR THE 29TH STREET SHARED USE PATH PROJECT, A TRANSPORTATION ALTERNATIVES SET-ASIDE (TASA) PROGRAM PROJECT, AS COMPETITIVELY SELECTED BY THE BRYAN/COLLEGE STATION METROPOLITAN PLANNING ORGANIZATION AS AN OFF-SYSTEM PROJECT; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Bryan/College Station Metropolitan Planning Organization (BCSMPO) issued a call for projects in April 2025 for jurisdictions to apply for funding assistance through the Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside Program (TASA); and

WHEREAS, the 29th Street Shared Use Path was the number one priority for use of these Category 9 funds that are allocated to the BCSMPO and are administered by the Texas Department of Transportation and the TASA funds may only be used for construction of pedestrian and/or bicycle infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work for the overall project consists of constructing a shared use path from Carter Creek Parkway southward on the east side of East 29th Street to the intersection of Autumn Circle in College Station. A new separate pedestrian bridge will be constructed over Burton Creek as the existing roadway bridge is not wide enough to add the shared use path; and

WHEREAS, the City of Bryan is responsible for 20% local match of the actual costs associated with the construction contract and the City of Bryan would be responsible for all non-reimbursable costs and 100% of overruns, if any, for TASA funds; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Bryan desires to affirm its support of the Project, approve, and authorize the Mayor to execute an Advanced Funding Agreement for a Transportation Alternatives Set-Aside (TASA) Program Project with the Texas Department of Transportation for the 29th Street Shared Use Path Project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BRYAN, TEXAS:

1.

That the City Council hereby adopts and approves the recitals and findings set forth in the preamble above.

2.

That the Mayor is authorized to enter into an Advanced Funding Agreement with the Texas Department of Transportation for this project with anticipated local match of \$380,750 and Federal Funds in the amount of \$1,523,000 for the 29th Street Shared Use Path Project.

3.

It is hereby found and determined that the meeting at which this Resolution was adopted was open to the public as required by law and that notice of the time, place, and purpose of said meeting was given as required by Chapter 551, Texas Government Code.
