**Grimes County Attorney - Megan Barcak**

1. Discuss and appoint a committee in accordance with the Executive Summary of Guidelines and Criteria for Tax Abatements Pursuant to Texas Tax Code Chapter 312 and for Grants Pursuant to Texas Local Government Code Chapter 381. It is expected that the court will conduct a closed session as authorized by Texas Government Code § 551.0745 to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a member of an advisory body. (Personnel Matters).
2. EXECUTIVE SESSION: the Commissioners Court will meet in a closed/executive session pursuant to Section 551.087 of the Texas Government Code to discuss or deliberate regarding commercial or financial information that the Commissioners Court has received from Space Exploration Technologies Corp. The Commissioners Court is conducting economic development negotiations and will deliberate an offer of financial or other incentive to the business prospect of a multi-phase, next-generation, vertically integrated semiconductor manufacturing and advanced computing fabrication facility, proposed to be located at the Gibbons Creek Reservoir and surrounding areas.
3. EXECUTIVE SESSION: It is expected that the Commissioners Court will meet in a closed/executive session pursuant to Section 551.087 of the Texas Government Code to discuss commercial or financial information that the Commissioners Court has received from a business prospect that the Commissioners Court seeks to have locate, stay, or expand within the County in the Navasota Industrial Park and with which the Commissioners Court is conducting economic development negotiations, and to deliberate the offer of a financial or other incentive to the business prospect: proposed manufacturing facility for heat-transfer equipment and thermal-management systems for cooling, refrigeration, and industrial processing applications.
